Prizes

3. Writing (including poems) by Young People:
1st prize £50. Five runners up of £10 each

Poetry

Original poems written in any style, but not exceeding 40 lines are eligible in this category.

Other Writing

Entries can include short texts, stories, essays, dialogues, mini-dramas, monologues and lyrics, none of which must exceed 500 words.

Writing by Young People

Poems no more than 40 lines or general writing no more than 500 words by young people 14 years and under. The work submitted in this category may be illustrated. All winning entries to be published on the Sefton Arts website and to appear in the January to April edition of the magazine.
